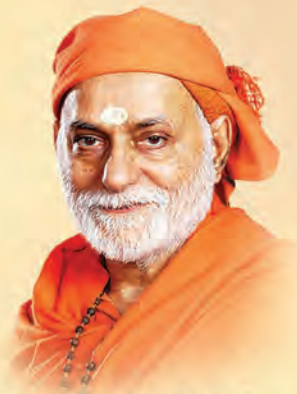

#### **Knowledge Festival**

**Harih Om Tat Sat.** We are pleased to announce that the Annual Knowledge Festival exposing the supreme values and Truths - Parama Tattva Sameeksha Satram - jointly organized by Narayanashtama Tapovanam and Hind Navotthana Pratishthan, will be conducted in all effectiveness this year also, in the holy month of Margaseersham, between 19<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> December 2025 in Sabha Niketan, Naimishaaranyam, Paralikad.

Often great events follow humble beginnings. This is true of Naimishaaranyam and Tattva Sameeksha Satram. For, it was in 2001 that Paralikad villagers felt like holding Srimad Bhaagavata Saptaham, then an unprecedented event for the village residents. Prof. Vaidyalinga Sharma was the speaker. The whole event was so enlightening and fulfilling to the participants that, by the time it concluded, they strongly felt they should get an opportunity to listen to the truths, values and principles Vyasadeva has propounded in the great Text. For, that alone would help them to lead their lives based on the eternal values of our rich and composite Culture, a duty our Constitution has enjoined on all the citizens.

It was in pursuit of this ardent wish of the village folk that we resolved to conduct the yearly Knowledge Festival, Tattva Sameeksha Satram, especially emphasizing the great values Vyasadeva has discussed and revealed. Considering the needs of the audience, Sabha Niketan with modern amenities was built, providing inspiration for further value-inculcational activities. Every second Saturday, a full-day satsang known as 'Vyasaprasadam' is held there, with over 150 devotees and seekers participating regularly.

#### **Recitation by students and prize distribution**

The prize distribution for the winners of the competitions conducted to train students in reciting shlokas, aimed at enhancing

their contemplational skills, willpower and focus, will take place on 25th December.

5161 years have passed since the Mahabharata war transpired in Kurukshetra. No further fighting has taken place there. But every one faces the war of life, with its varied challenges and tolls. However, our ancestors have guardedly kept intact over the millennia Bhagavad Gita and Vishnusahasranama, Bharat's invaluable cultural treasures. These have the power to enrich and empower the inner personality, enabling one to be more effective in his field of activity and be a greater performer. Moreover, the ability to read, understand and pursue whatever one learns also grows considerably. Many confirm this with their own experiential benefits.

As inner blessedness is essential for young people, it is the bounden duty of all householders to support this endeavour. After all, children grow up under the guidance of their parents.

Understanding the Ultimate Truth is the only means to gain relief from the three-fold miseries (*aadhidaivika*, *aadhibhoutika* and *aadhyaatmika*) that life in the world brings about. The objective of Naimishaaranyam Knowledge Festival is to inculcate truthful introspection, thereby sharpening the intellect and inspiring people to pursue our age-old time-tested values. Audience experiences further affirm this, and everyone has enough reason to be grateful.

## **Programs**

On most days, I will be addressing the audience. Over the ten days, 38 exponents, including Swami Nirvisheshananda Tirtha and Ma Gurupriya from Narayanashrama Tapovanam, will unveil the value treasure of Sreemad Bhaagavatam to the listeners. Apart from 5 lectures every day exposing the truths, values and principles enshrined in Sreemad Bhaagavatam, recitation of the full Text will also be there. Lofty and progressive behavioural changes among the villagers in the last 23 years stand as proof to the effects the yearly Knowledge festival has brought about. For devotees from



abroad as well as those from other parts of Bharat, lectures in English will be held on the 24<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> December.

### **Vishnusahasranaama Samooaha Mahayajna**

On the concluding day December 28<sup>th</sup>, as in previous years, is the Vishnusahasranaama Samooaha Mahayajna from morning 9.00 am to 2:00 pm with prasada distribution. Students and devotees from Bharat and the world can participate in Vishnusahasranaama Samooaha Mahayajna aimed at instilling goodness, well-being, unity and self-confidence in all people. Those unable to sit on floor may sit on chair and do the recitational archana.

Besides meetings and allied means to generate public awareness about the Knowledge festival, Ghosha Yatras to Naimisharanyam, as usual, accompanying Sri Krishna Idol from Guruvayur, Dharma Dhawja from Thiruvilvamaala and Sreemad Bhaagavatam Text from Narayanashrama Tapovanam will be conducted.

Competitions on Sreemad Bhaagavatam text for high school and college students will be conducted, as in earlier years. This year, the competitions are divided into three categories: Sub-Junior for children up to the fourth class, Junior for classes five to eight, and Senior for those in classes nine to twelve. The Junior and Senior categories include competitions in recitation of shlokas, elocution, essay writing and quiz. Additionally Vishnusahasranaama and Srimad Bhagavad Gita shloka recitation competitions are held for students of various schools.

### **Subjects for Competition:**

Selections for poetic recitation are 10 shlokas from Sreemad Bhaagavatam 11.28.16 to 25 (Sree Krishna summarises the instructions given to Uddhava) and 10 shlokas from 12.8.40 to 49 (the supreme truth Markandeya submits before Nara and Narayana), assigned to the Junior and Senior categories. 'The greatness and untold strength of devotion Ambareesha's life exposes' and 'Gajendra's viveka that at once obliterated the torment of worldliness'

are the subjects for essay writing (upanyasa). Topics for elocution for juniors and seniors are 'Glory of friendship sparkling in rice flakes' and 'Spiritual values proclaimed in the churning of 'Nectar'.

For the Sub-Junior students, it is Anushtup shlokas from 10.38.28 to 37 (related to the incarnation of Sri Krishna). In addition to shloka recitation, there will also be storytelling (topic: Valorous heart enabling Krishna to dance on serpent's hood).

For group chanting competitions, Bhagavad Gita Chapter 15 and Vishnusahasranaama slokas 21-40 have been selected.

The quiz session will be primarily based on the Tenth Skandha Uttarardha (second half).

### **An Opportunity for all:**

Anna-daanam will be part of the Knowledge festival. On request, accommodation will be provided for outstation devotees. Both Ashrams' book stalls, medical support stall and counters for devotional offerings will be arranged. Estimated cost of the Jnana Festival is Rs 70 lakhs.

We fondly invite all of you to heartily participate in this Knowledge festival either in person or online, along with your family and friends, so that they too will have an opportunity to gain blessings.
